

Kinetic Church Family Drawing

[Parents and teachers: Please refrain from giving the children ideas of what to draw as it is important that the children express whatever they interpret the instructions to mean and draw an expression of the image as they see it. *There is no wrong answer*. If the children ask for further instructions, simply repeat the instructions below. If a child continues to struggle (perhaps because they are a very literal thinker), simply walk the child through each section of the instructions asking them to interpret each piece individually. For example: Draw a picture. Do you know what that means? Of people in your Church. Who are the people in your Church? Include you. Where would you be? Doing something. What are you and people in your Church doing?]

Part 1:

Instructions: Draw a picture of people in your Church, including you, doing something (some kind of action).

Part 2:

Instructions: Draw a picture of people in your Church, including you, doing something that you would like to do together if you could do *anything* that you wanted together.
