

WHEN CAN YOU GET A COVID-19 VACCINE?



The COVID-19 vaccine will be distributed in phases. All Kentuckians will have access to a vaccine.

- Long term care facilities
- Assisted living facilities
- Health care personnel



Phase 1a

- Anyone age 70 or older
- First Responders
- Kentucky K-12 school personnel
- Kentucky child care workers



Phase 1b

- Anyone age 50 or older
- Anyone age 16 or older with medical or behavioral health conditions per the CDC that "are" or "might be" at increased risk of severe COVID-19 disease,
- All essential workers



Phase 1c

We are here
March 22, 2021

- Anyone age 40 or older



Phase 2

- Anyone age 16 or older



Phase 3

- Children under the age of 16 if the vaccine is approved for this age group



Phase 4

The state's goal is to administer 90% or more of all vaccine doses received in the state within seven days of arrival. The phases provide clarity on when more Kentuckians can get the vaccine and helps providers understand what order vaccines should be administered.
