Summary:

The Catholic School Principal is a joyful, faith-filled, innovative, and experienced leader with an unwavering commitment to providing a Catholic education of the highest quality. The principal will oversee the core executive functions of a vibrant Catholic school and will work to ensure that the school's Catholic identity emanates throughout the curricular, extracurricular, and relational dimensions of the school. As an educational leader the principal directs and coordinates the planning, implementation, and evaluation of the total educational program. The successful candidate will form engaging relationships with students, parents, faculty and staff, and other stakeholders while maintaining the overall mission of the school.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensure a strong Catholic identity throughout all school operations
- Oversee day-to-day school operations
- Manage school logistics and budgets
- Set learning goals for students and teachers based on national curricula
- Oversee the implementation of the School Choice program within the school
- Monitor and report on teacher performance
- Oversee all aspects of assessment including formative, summative and state assessments
- Research new resources and techniques to improve teaching and learning
- Interview and hire school personnel
- Review and implement diocesan and school policies
- Provide guidance and counseling to teachers
- Handle emergencies and school crises
- Organize school events and assemblies
