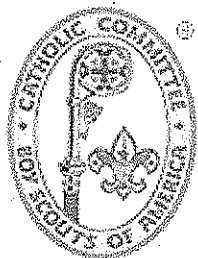

What is the Bronze Pelican?



The Bronze Pelican Award is a recognition approved by the Diocese of Owensboro Catholic Committee on Scouting. It may be presented to any adult who is working in the Scouting program under the Catholic auspices, and to those who have made significant contribution to Scouting in the Religious Emblems program of the Catholic Church.

The recipient is not entitled to wear the BSA Adult Religious Award square knot on their uniform since the Bronze Pelican is a Diocesan, rather than a national award.

In order to evaluate the nominee, please provide as much detail as possible about the candidate's involvement in the Catholic Church, their community, and their actions that exhibit the principles of Catholic Scouting.

Requirements

Recipients of the award must be exemplary adults who are certified by their Scout Council as registered Scouters currently serving in an active position. Those recipients who are Catholic must have the approval of their Pastor.

This award is to be given only to active leaders registered in the Boy Scouts of America - no honorary awards are to be presented.

The recipients of this award are to be sought after and selected by an active committee.

1. Be a registered Scouter.
2. Promotion of Catholic values by personal example.
3. Active involvement in their Parish and community.
