a renewed commitment to stoke the flames of your spiritual life.

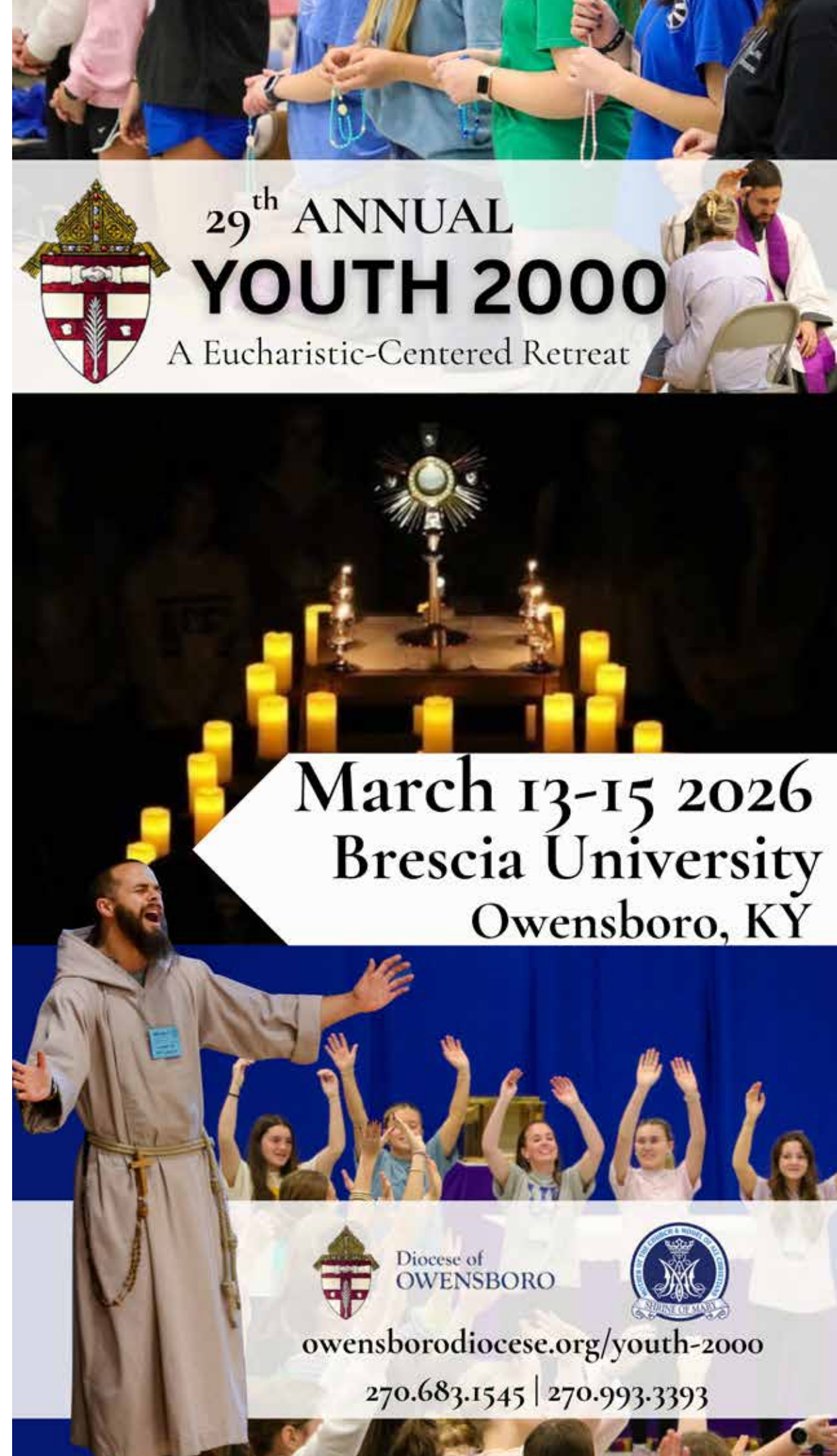
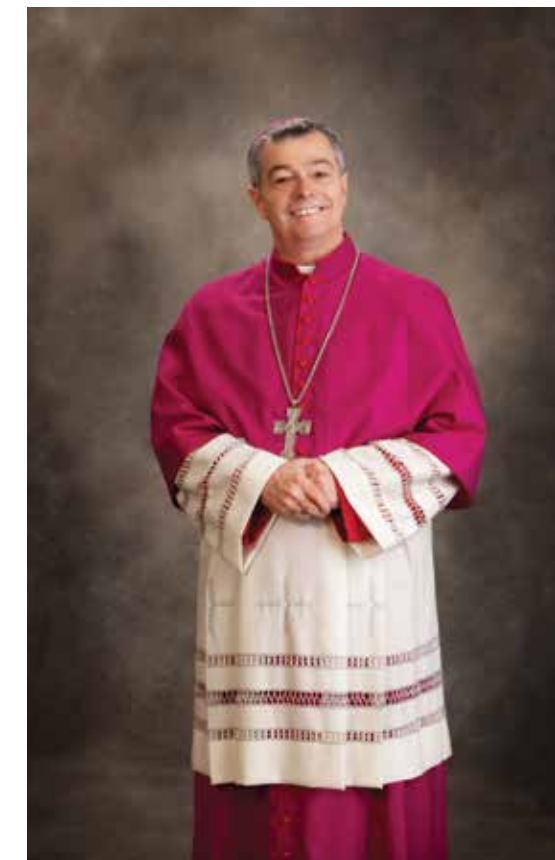
Our diocese is indebted to the Marian Shrine Event Committee and our diocesan Office

YOUTH 2000

The challenging message of World Youth Day in 1993 has been picked up throughout the United States through an initiative called YOUTH 2000.

The prayer festivals of YOUTH 2000 produce leaders among youth; leaders like those called forth by St. Pope John Paul II in his homily during World Youth Day in Denver, on August 15, 1993, when he challenged the young people to not be ashamed of the Gospel, to be willing to preach it from the rooftops and to make Christ known in the modern world. *(Paraphrased from the late St. John Paul II's August 15, 1993 homily on the 8th World Youth Day.)*

YOUTH 2000 leads young people to a personal encounter with Jesus Christ in the Eucharist; to live and proclaim the Gospel message with joy and enthusiasm; and to become evangelizers of the New Evangelization.

Registration Information

The Registration Form and Liability Release are enclosed and must be filled out by chaperones and participants. All forms for participants ages 18 and over must be filled out in advance. All forms for participants ages 17 or younger must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. Participants are encouraged to pre-register by March 3, 2026. The registration fee is **\$65.00 per person**. If registering with others at your parish, please make your check payable to your parish. If registering as an individual, then checks may be made payable to the Marian Shrine Committee.

Participants who wait to register at the door must bring their payment and have the chaperone, liability release and registration forms signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Additional donations to help offset the costs are gratefully accepted. Financial assistance is available for those in need.

Program

The YOUTH 2000 Retreat program brings young people to know the joy of a life lived in the worship of God and in service to God’s people, and empowers them to go forth with renewed faith, to be witnesses to the Faith, to share the Good News and to be the evangelizers in this world. Through talks, music, adoration, prayer, panel discussions, fellowship, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and the celebration of the Mass, the young people deepen their love and understanding of the Catholic faith, and encounter the power and richness of God’s love and mercy.

Chaperones

All chaperones must fulfill and be in compliance with the diocesan policies and require-

ments for providing a safe and secure environment for minors. Please see the Group Registration Form for more information. **You must have 2 chaperones at least 21 years of age, for the first 7 youth. For each additional 7 youth, 1 chaperone is required. If you are staying overnight and you have both male and female youth you need to have a male and female chaperone.** Please refer to Diocese of Owensboro Safe Environment Policy at <https://owensborodiocese.org/safe-environment-policies/> for information on overnight trips, etc. The chaperone registration form and fee must accompany the youth(s) form(s). Parents or legal guardians assume responsibility for finding a chaperone.

Housing/Hotel

The information provided regarding hotels is strictly for your convenience. YOUTH 2000 has no relationship with these hotels. 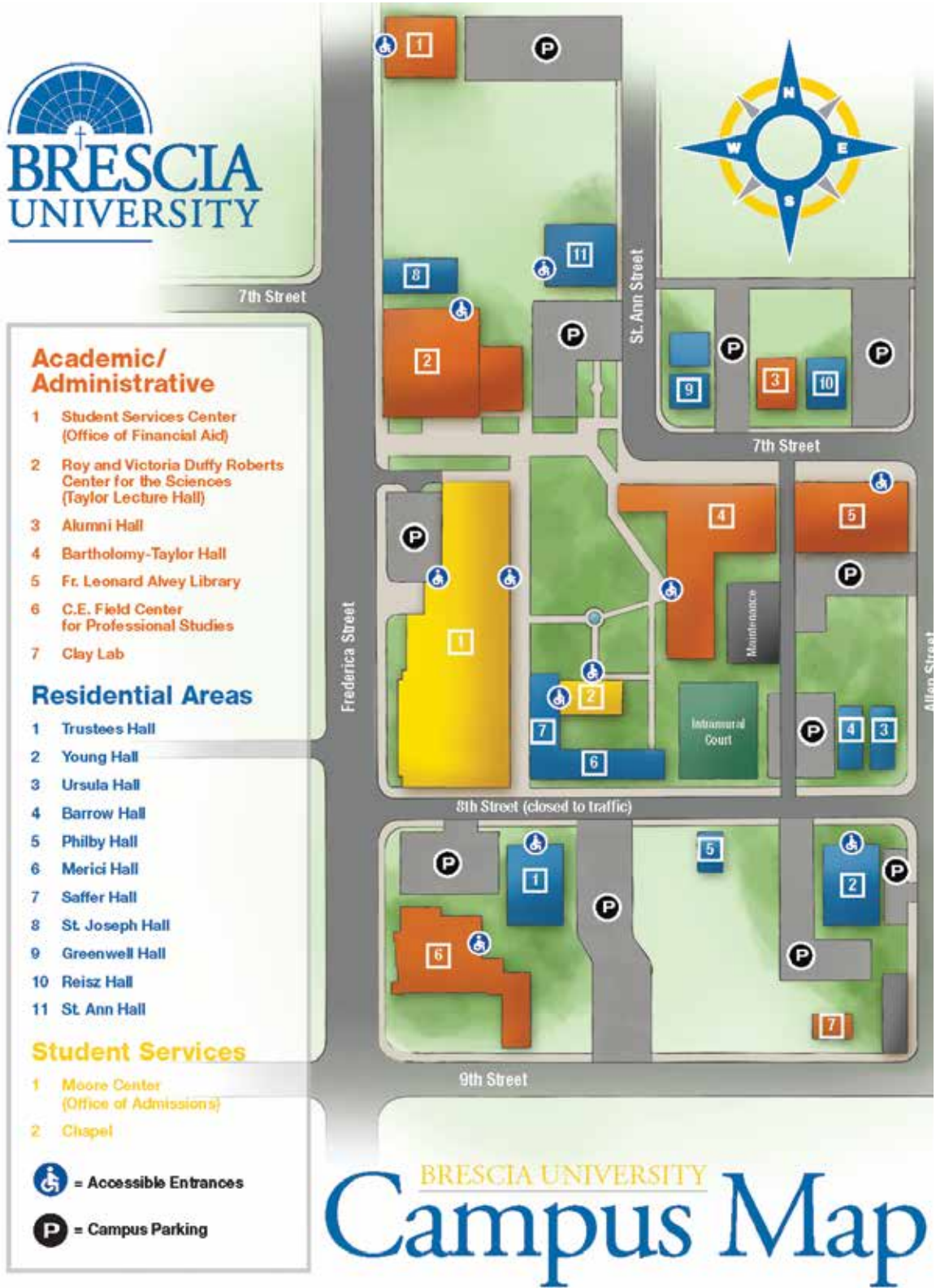
Meals
